

# **BRITISH COLUMBIA SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS -**

The following requirements are specific to the CEC Location #847 Langley, BC. The policies listed below are IN ADDITION to the other requirements listed in our Phase 1 Reopening Procedures documentation and other information in this Supplemental Documentation document. The requirements below will supersede any instance listed in the primary documentation, specifically if the listed requirements are MORE restrictive than the “corporate standard”.

## **Maximum Capacity**

- The maximum allowable capacity for this location shall not exceed more than 150 Guests at a time, this number does not include employees or other personnel required for daily operations.

## **No Parties/Events**

- At this time, no private/reserved parties will be allowed at this location. Reservation capabilities have been deactivated from our guest facing website for any parties until further notice.

## **Mask Requirements**

- Location management will do everything in their power to comply with Ministerial order M 425 2020 regarding compulsory wearing of masks indoors. We believe that our already existing policies regarding required masks for employees as well as signage and communication practices with Guests meet or exceed these requirements as written, and will continue to adhere to these policies until the standard order is lifted. We will encourage adherence to policy with Guests but will leave strict enforcement to law enforcement personnel.

## **Allowed Seating & Guest Movement**

- In order to separate the gaming and dining portions of the facility, food may only be consumed in the “Showroom” portion of the restaurant. The Tables in the Showroom must follow all requirements for social distancing and maximum seating capacities based on both Local requirements and approved standards listed above.
  - All other seating in the gaming area of the restaurant is to be closed off and marked with appropriate and approved signage.
- Additionally, in order to prevent guests from moving back and forth between the dining and gaming areas, all guests will be required to separate their dining and gaming portions of their visit (i.e. they must purchase and play all games first before choosing to dine or vice versa). If a Guest purchases both games and food on their transaction they will notify the Manager/Cashier which they would like to be done first and we will accommodate their request.
  - This separation is also applied to beverage purchases. Guests may not purchase any kind of beverage to consume while playing games. If they do, it must be purchased separately.

## **Restrictions on Live shows**

- Due to restrictions on background noise and entertainment. Our hourly “live shows” as well as appearances by Chuck E. Cheese himself are cancelled until further notice. Additionally, background music in the location will be reduced to lower than normal volumes.
